**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1914 lowers the legal limit a person is considered driving under the influence from 0.08 to 0.05 blood or breath alcohol concentration.

The Department of Corrections notes any incarceration increases would be dependent on the number of future convictions, and the agency is unable to determine a fiscal impact. The Department has provided the marginal/incremental cost of an incarcerated inmate, which is \$67.26 per day or \$24,549.90 per year.
