**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1925 adds a minimum term of imprisonment of 6 months to the penalties for violating a protection order. The measure also changes the violations that resulted in the injury of the to the plaintiff as a class D1 felony instead of a misdemeanor. The measure also increases the maximum term of imprisonment for the new felony from 1 year to 3 years.

The Department of Corrections notes any incarceration increases would be dependent on the number of future convictions, and the agency is unable to determine a fiscal impact. The Department has provided the marginal/incremental cost of an incarcerated inmate, which is \$67.26 per day or \$24,549.90 per year.
