**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 2022 requires DHS to administer SNAP using eligibility standards, benefit determinations, work requirements, time limits, exemptions, and verification procedures that are no less restrictive than those required by federal law. The measure also requires that an able-bodied adult without dependents shall not receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits beyond the applicable federal time limit unless the individual meets the work, workfare, education, or training requirements specified in federal law or qualifies for an exemption explicitly authorized in statute or regulation

DHS expects no fiscal impact to carry out the provisions of this measure.
