**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 2028 requires any person selling or offering raw milk or raw milk products to notify the consumer that the product is not licensed, regulated, or inspected. The measure also provides that the transportation of such products to consumers shall not be subject to the provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act. The proposal increases the annual maximum amount of gallons that may be sold to be classified as incidental sales from 100 gallons to 1,500 gallons and authorizes such sales to include all milk products rather than goat milk products.

The Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry does not expect a fiscal impact.
