**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 2034 states that the criminal record will automatically be expunged for any person who was convicted of a nonviolent misdemeanor if 10 years have passed since the conviction, the person has not been convicted of a felony, all fines and fees are paid, and if the person has no pending felonies or misdemeanors.

The measure yields no fiscal impact.
