**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 2151 states that a defendant convicted of an 85% crime may instead serve 65% of the sentence prior to becoming eligible for parole.

The fiscal impact of the measure is a one-time cost estimated at \$121,500. Implementation would require vendor-supported system modifications to the ICON system.
