HOUSE CONCURRENT
RESOLUTION 1003

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution relating to Joint Rules;
Legislative Division of Administrative Code Review.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF
THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

At the next opportunity whereby Joint Rules of operation are
being considered for adoption by the Legislature the following Rule
Set shall be considered for adoption:

A. The Legislature hereby establishes the Legislative Division
of Administrative Code Review, which shall be tasked with reviewing
proposed administrative rules of state agencies. The Division shall
employ individuals as approved by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House
of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the State
Senate.

B. The Division is tasked with evaluating the following:

1 1. Whether proposed permanent administrative rules align with
2 the Oklahoma Constitution;

3 2. Whether proposed permanent rules fulfill the legislative
4 intent of the statute that authorized the permanent rulemaking;

5 3. Whether the proposed permanent rules will have a negative
6 impact that is disproportionate to the intended effects of the
7 rulemaking; and

8 4. Whether the agency has the statutory authority to promulgate
9 the proposed permanent rules.

10 C. The Division shall issue a report including the information
11 provided in subsection B of this section, a summary statement of the
12 legislative recommendation being made, and any other information
13 deemed necessary by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
14 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, and
15 the Administrative Rules Committee Chairs of the Oklahoma House of
16 Representatives and the State Senate.

17 D. The Division may also be responsible for regular evaluations
18 of existing provisions of the administrative code as directed by the
19 Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the President Pro
20 Tempore of the State Senate, and the Administrative Rules Committee
21 Chairs of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the State
22 Senate.
