15	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17	the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
18	Oklahoma by adding a new Section 36 to Article VI thereof, to read
19	as follows:
20	Section 36. A. The Legislature shall, by law, create an
21	election recall process for statewide elected officials.

23	1. The Governor;

Election recalls shall be set by the Governor no later than the General Election following the submission of the required 11 12 signatures to the Secretary of State. 13 E. The Legislature shall enact the election recall process no 14 later than the end of the legislative session following the approval 15 of this measure by vote of the people. 16 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in 17 18 the following form: 19 BALLOT TITLE Legislative Referendum No. State Question No. 20 21 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS: 22 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution by adding a new 23 Section 36 to Article 6.
