8 AS INTRODUCED

10 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
11 to refer to the people for their approval or
12 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 2 of
13 Article XXV-A of the Constitution of the State of
14 Oklahoma; allowing the State of Oklahoma not cover
15 Medicaid expansion if federal financial participation
16 drops below ninety-percent matching; providing ballot
17 title; and directing filing.

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
20 2ND SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

21 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
22 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
23 the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article XXV-A of
24 the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

25 A. In addition to those otherwise eligible for medical
26 assistance under Oklahoma's Medicaid program, the State shall
27 provide medical assistance under Oklahoma's Medicaid program to Low
28 Income Adults.

B. No greater or additional burdens or restrictions on eligibility or enrollment shall be imposed on persons eligible for medical assistance pursuant to this Article than on any other population eligible for medical assistance under Oklahoma's Medicaid program.

C. If the federal financial participation is less than ninety percent (90%) for Medicaid expansion, the Oklahoma Legislature may decide to not cover the additional costs to the state.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. The measure amends Section 2 of Article 25A by allowing the State of Oklahoma to not cover the Medicaid expansion if the federal financial participation drops below ninety percent (90%) matching.
